Frédéric Gastaldo's professional career began in 1986 at UGINE ACG, a French-US stainless steel manufacturer, before moving to the Boston Consulting Group Paris Office.

He later joined Cegetel Entreprises (Vivendi) in France as Chief Technology Officer (CTO) and in 1998 he became co-founder and CEO of Louis Dreyfus Communications - renamed into Neuf Telecom - the largest french fixed telecommunications rival to France Télécom.
